

PSAT 8/9 Information

Twelve Bridges Middle School will be administering the PSAT 8/9 test on March 1 and March 2 to all interested 8th grade students. March 1 will be a brief session of pre- registration. The actual exam will be administered on March 2nd. The duration of the exam, with breaks, is approximately 3 hours.

The registration forms are due back to the TBMS Counselor (Wendy Hollis) by Friday February 23. The cost to take the exam is \$10 and must be paid in advance, in cash. The forms can be found in the main office, English teachers will hand them out or our school website. The PSAT 8/9 measures what the student is already learning, shows them whether they're on track for college, and lets them know where they need the most improvement. That means students have time to tackle these areas long before they take the SAT.

Students over 13 years of age can share their scores with Khan Academy to create a personalized practice experience. It's the best way to prepare for other tests in the SAT Suite of Assessments and it's free.
